With this money, we were able to supply every child with refreshments for the Christmas Pantomime, buy new bookshelves for the library, and raised £171 towards new books, which will be arriving shortly. We also funded and arranged a visit from local award winning author Sue Wilkins, who spent time reading and talking with the children in each of the classrooms.
