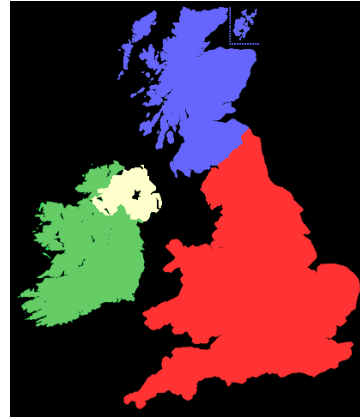


# Year 1

## Autumn 1 Overview

### Magical Mapping



#### English

Children will read a collection of stories by the author Simon Bartram including *Man on the Moon* and *Bob's Best Friend*. They will explore language features of the books, sequence and orally retell the stories, compare the similarities and differences of the two books and work towards writing a new version of the story.

#### Maths

Children will spend the first part of the half term consolidating and building on the knowledge of numbers to ten, showing the numbers in different ways including part, part wholes. This knowledge will then be used and applied to addition and subtraction, using practical objects and developing their mental maths fluency. Children will also learn their numbers to 10 and start to increase their quick fire recall skills.

#### Geography

This half term in Geography the children will be learning about their local area and the key features. They will be comparing South Wingfield to Derby city. We will then look at England and our capital city and the countries that make up the United Kingdom. We will do a field trip, work on our map and compass skills.

They consider how creation stories help some people understand what God is like.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PSHE</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Being Responsible</b></p> <p>Children explore why rules are needed and what rules we have to follow. They will think about why being responsible is important and what they have responsibility for. We will like this to caring for the environment.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Computing</b></p> <p>Knowing how to log in and navigate around a computer, developing mouse skills, learning how to drag, drop, click and control a cursor to create works of art inspired by Kandinsky and self-portraits.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Music</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Hey You!</b></p> <p><b>Hey You!</b> is written in an Old-School Hip Hop style for children to learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.</p> <p>As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other Old-School Hip Hop tunes.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PE</b></p> <p>One session will be with AVSSP and then this will be consolidated in a second PE in class 1.</p> <p>This half term we will be developing our Athletics skills with running, jumping and throwing activities.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>The Human Body</b></p> <p>In Science we will be learning about the Human body, in particular our senses. We will be doing lots of hands on practical learning where we explore each of the senses.</p> <p>At the end of the half term we will look at the season Autumn.</p>
