



# Class 4 Foxes Newsletter Autumn 2



Hello and welcome back! I hope you've all had a lovely half term and a fantastic Halloween for those who celebrate! I'm sure plenty of sweets have been eaten! Autumn 2 is always a very busy term filled with fun activities on the run up to Christmas. I have included as much information as possible on this newsletter but if anything else is added/changed I will be sure to let you know via Class Dojo.

At the beginning of each term, I will upload the new term documents to the class page on the website and to our class story on Dojo, these will include everything that you and your child need to know ready for the upcoming term including:

- Medium term plan which says what we will be covering in each subject - this will also be printed out
- Newsletter with important dates for the term – this will also be printed out
- Weekly spellings for the term - these will also be printed and put in the children's bags
- Knowledge Organisers for Topic, science, and Computing. These have useful facts and vocabulary on them to help support the children's learning throughout the term.

## **Topics we will be learning in Autumn 2!**

During Autumn 2 children will have the opportunity to learn about the Stone Age to the Iron Age, children will learn that prehistory is the time before written records began and that we know about this time from the sources of evidence left behind that have been studied by archaeologists. They will learn that prehistoric times went through a series of ages, during which early Britons made huge technological advances for the time and left a lasting mark on the British landscape. Children will also explore key concepts such as settlement, migration, tribe and technology.

- During science this term Y4 children are going to be looking at states of matter. They will be looking at exploring solids liquids and gases. Changing states, using scientific equipment, measuring temperature changes, learning about the water cycle and completing an evaporation experiment.

For the topics children will be covering in all other subjects please make sure to have a look at the **Medium-Term Plan which is on our class page on the school website.**

### PE in Class 4

Children will have PE twice a week, one of them being taught by Amber Valley and the other being taught by their class teacher. Children will be coming into school dressed in their sports clothes therefore PE kits do not need to be brought into school. **Please be aware that this year we would like children to follow our PE policy in regards to PE uniform which is a plain white/ black or blue t-shirt, black/blue joggers or shorts and sensible footwear. No named brands or football shirts please. Last half term we had some children that were coming in clothes that were not suitable for PE, it is not a non school uniform day.** For Class 4 children need to come in their PE kits on a **Tuesday and a Thursday.**

### Reading expectation in school and at home

In school children will be part of a guided reading group and will also have the opportunity to read individually to an adult at school. They will be expected to read at least 3 times a week at home, but **5 times is the ideal.** It does not always have to be their reading book, it may be a book of their own choice, a comic or even a newspaper. **It would be helpful if reading at home was recorded in their reading record by either the child or an adult.**

Once children let me know that they have finished their reading book, they will change it and I will write their new book in their reading record. If your child does finish a book, they can do comprehension activities linking to the book they have read, this might be answering questions on the book, writing a book review, retelling the story etc.

Reading in KS2 is not just about fluency it is also about comprehension and understanding of the text, reading comprehension is something that we will be focussing on a lot this term in Class 4.

We have a huge variety of new books both in our school library and the reading corner in our classroom, my main aim as is to get as many children to love reading as possible, therefore if your child has finished book bands and is a library reader and is not enjoying the book they have chosen they are more than welcome to ask me if they can swap it. I don't want any child to feel like they have to finish a book just because they've chosen it.

**Please can I remind you that it is the expectation that children bring their reading packet with the book and reading record into school EVERY day.** Last term we had children forgetting their reading packet and they ended up missing out on notices, 1-1 reading with an adult etc.

**Every Friday** I will check the reading children have done at home, any parent notes that have been written in there and as a class we will also write down their homework, spelling rule and times table for the following week.

### **Homework in Class 4**

Last term your child was given a folder with all their log in details to our online schemes. (Spelling shed, TT Rockstars, Sumdog) It is important your child keeps this safe!

If children lose their username and password for an online scheme, please email me and I will resend it to you. There is an expectation that your child logs onto **TT Rockstars and Spelling Shed at home.**

Homework will be completed online using the platforms **SumDog or Spelling Shed.** Sumdog is an online maths programme linking to the work we are doing in our maths lessons and Spelling shed links to the children's weekly spellings. Homework will not be set every week but when it is I will write it in your child's reading record and also put a message on class dojo.

Each term children will also be asked to complete a homework project relating to the topic that we are learning in class. Our topic for Autumn 2 is Stone Age to Iron Age therefore I would like children to choose something that interests them about this topic and produce a piece of work around this. Their work could take any form. It could be a PowerPoint presentation, a piece of writing, a combination of typed up research and hand-drawn pictures, they might like to do some artwork or produce a model, write a story, song, or poem. Children can complete their piece of topic homework at any point during our Autumn 2 term and they are more than welcome to bring it into school to show the rest of the class and if possible, have it added to our topic display. However, if you would prefer to email your child's topic homework to me then that is absolutely fine too! I can then print a picture of it out for display.

## Class Dojo

As you may be aware from last half term we have now set up Class Dojo. Lots of parents are connected to our class page which is fantastic to see! Children will be given dojo points linking to our school rules of being ready, respectful and safe. You can also communicate to with me via message on the app too. All of our beginning of term documents will also be uploaded to our class page as well as a Friday round up message. **Please can I remind parents that class dojo is not to be used to let school know about absences or appointments as the messaging system is not always checked during the school day so can any absences or appointments please go through the school office.**

## Other useful information

- If possible, could all uniform and water bottles please be **labelled!** Children will keep their jumpers on their pegs if they take them off and their water bottles will stay on their desks throughout the day. However, making sure everything is labelled just ensures no mix ups at home time!
- Mrs Pepper will teach the children for my PPA on a Thursday afternoon
- Mrs Pepper will be helping out in Class 4 every morning alongside Di.
- **Every Friday** children will have a weekly spelling test and TT Rockstars test. Children have been given their weekly spellings for the term and the times table they need to practice for TT Rockstars is on the math's section of the medium-term plan. I will send a text message home every Friday letting you know your child's spelling score.
- On the South Wingfield website, we have a class page. At the beginning of term, I will upload all the term documents to this page! If you would like to have a look at these, you can find out class page under. Children- Class pages- Class 4 Foxes.
