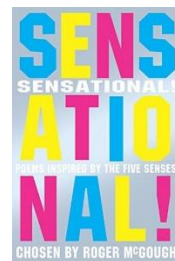
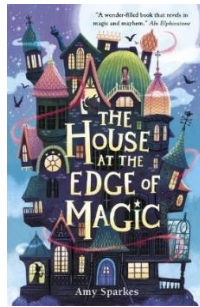


SPAG/English

SPAG- Children will be learning a range of techniques that link to our style of writing including: adverbs, fronted adverbials, apostrophes. They will also be learning their spelling rule for the week and completing work based around this.

English- Children will be writing a diary entry. They will be putting themselves in the shoes of the main character from our book Dragon Mountain and writing a diary entry all about their adventures.

Geography- China

During this topic children will be immersed in the amazing country of China. They will start by exploring China's location and its many diverse physical and human features, before going on to learn about the country's economic growth and the effect this has had on both the people and the land. Finally, they will explore the famous attractions and culture of China, giving children a great overview of what China is like!



Maths

Children will be continuing with multiplication and division looking at how to multiply 3 and 4 digit numbers by 1 and 2 digit numbers. They will also be working on multiplication and division problems.

Children will then move on and begin their topic of fractions, they will be looking at equivalent fractions, common denominators, and mixed numbers.

PE kit needs to be worn on a Tuesday please. We have a PE uniform policy that needs to be followed, please see the newsletter for more information.

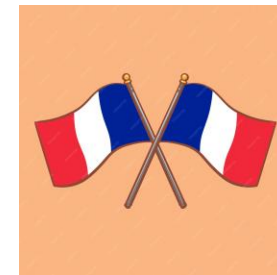
Art- Mega Materials
